Poinciana High School is a comprehensive, 4-year public school offering a well-rounded educational program to students from the Osceola-Polk County line to the Poinciana Community in Osceola County. PHS opened its doors in the Fall of 1991 and graduated its first senior class the same year. Poinciana High School is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

The academic program is organized into seven periods a day. Students can earn seven credits per year from their course load; students spend an average of 55 minutes in each period. PHS offers 21 Advanced Placement courses in a variety of subject areas.

GPA is computed using the above system. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation.

A minimum of 24 credits are required for graduation. In addition, each student must complete .5 credits in an online course, as well as, pass various state assessments.

AP & DE courses are weighted by one (1) point and Honors courses by one half (.5) point.

Grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is calculated in January and June.
